

2008 - 2009 INFORMATION SHEETS – UNITED JUNIOR SOCCER

Please keep these sheets in a safe place, as you may need to refer to them during the soccer season.

All United Junior Soccer Teams will be registered – EPYSA

In addition to the Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the following will be in effect for the 2008-2009 season.

- 1) All teams cannot have more than 18 players registered on their roster for the Under 11 thru Under 19 and 14 players for Under 8 thru Under 10. This includes Cup play. There are NO secondary players with the exception of the Under 16 thru Under 19 age groups. EPYSA registered winter teams Under 15 thru Under 19 may carry 22 players on their roster.
- 2) Every club must be represented at two consecutive meetings or else is considered a member in bad standing and can forfeit all rights to being a member of the United Junior Soccer League.
- 3) All clubs NOT having insurance with EPYSA, must present a copy of the insurance policy and/or insurance policy with each application stating that they have insurance coverage for their players.
- 4) All teams will have a bye week on the Columbus Day Weekend holiday.
- 5) 3 points for a win - 1 point for a tie – no points for a loss.

A listing of the Soccer Directors and Board of Directors are posted on the website. All schedules will be posted on the website as well. The League phone is to be used for calling the Games Commissioner and the Board of Directors for league matters. The winning coach will post the score on GAME DAY on the UJSL website. www.ujsl.com. There will be a link to direct you to the proper location. In the event of a tie, the home team will then post the score. Home teams are listed first on the schedules.

All Line-up sheets are computer generated from the EPYSA site with the players name and number. The coach or team manager must sign the Line-up sheet and present to the referee.

HOME TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE NETS, CORNER FLAGS AND LINING OF THE FIELD.

EVERY COACH IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR SPECTATORS.

Delinquency Fines/Fees

All application fees are due prior to the start of the season. Any club not paid in full, will not begin the season on time and will be subject to a \$25.00 fine per team. You will be sanctioned with the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association.
